1. The Parents/Guardians

I/We shall try to:

- Liaise with parents/guardians about appropriate home activities.
- Report to parents/guardians at once if their child is taken ill at school.
- Strictly enforce a written permission from a parent/ guardian concerning the accompanying of their children from school premises.

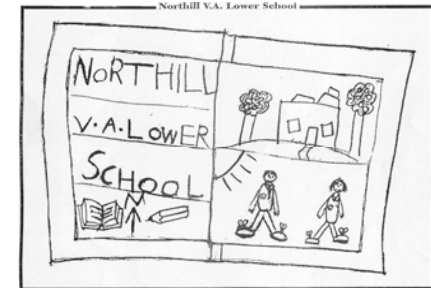
