

Spelling Practice – Northhill C of E VA Lower School

Dolphin Class – Early Years Foundation Stage
Children are taught word recognition in a game situation in groups and asked to write the word selected using small whiteboards. Children are asked to write words that are phonetically spelt independently when writing in different activities. Children are taught word recognition through games such as ‘spot the word’ whilst reading.
Owl Class – Years 1 and 2
Children ability grouped and given 8 – 10 spellings per week using words from Letters and Sounds Scheme.
Leopard Class – Years 3 and 4
Children are grouped by ability and given between 10 - 15 spellings per week using words from the literacy framework. If high frequency words are mis-spelt in written work, children will be asked to write them out correctly three times.
